Description

3 sections: barrel, one-piece body, bell. "Albert" system; 14 touchpieces; 6 rings; wood body; nickel-silver keys, rings, ferrules; has rollers for little finger keys; has patent C-sharp; has articulated C-sharp/G-sharp; has fork E-flat/B-flat; has a connector under C-sharp/G-sharp key to the E/B key in a Pupleschi-like articulation; possibly part of "matched" set with NMM 1409.

Dimensions

Measurements exclude tenons. Overall length (from tip of barrel to bottom of bell): 601.0 mm Barrel: 67.8 mm One-piece body: 425.0 mm Bell: 108.1 mm Bore at top of one-piece body: 14.7 mm Bore at bottom of one-piece body: 21.3 mm
