Description

One-part, singe-loop copper body with brass fittings. Six brass keys with flat key heads; lowest key open with heart-shaped adjustment screw, all others closed. Rectangular post mounts; pivots in tubular extension of key shanks Brass flat springs riveted to key shanks and guided in grooved extension of post mounts Undecorated brass garland Saxon rim with iron wire insert Tab seam extending over the entire tubing No tuning slide
