Description

Top: two-piece spruce: fine grain bound in ebony; C-shaped soundholes; tropical hardwood pierced rose with ivory ring Back: two-piece, quarter-cut maple: irregular, narrow curl descending from center joint Sides: slab-cut maple: very broad curl; one-piece lower rib Head and neck: maple: plain; pegbox terminates in an open scroll Fingerboard and tailpiece: tropical hardwood with open pores and prominent flecks with rosewood pieces at edges Pegs: rosewood
