



## Clarinet, B-flat

### Description

4 sections: barrel, top joint, bottom joint, bell. Simple system; 12 keys with flat, round key flaps; no rings; boxwood body; ivory ferrules; brass keys; Integral wood thumbrest; independent throat g-sharp key; two right hand side keys: for F/C and other trill for A-B or B-flat-C; late bore flare on bottom joint in German style; period mouthpiece that may be original.

### Dimensions

Measurements exclude tenons. Complete from top of barrel to bottom of bell: 578 mm Bore at bottom of top joint: 14.5 mm Height: 51.8 cm Upper joint: 187 mm Lower joint: 226 mm Barrel: 59.5 mm Bell: 108 mm Mouthpiece (chipped at tip): 66.5 cm Max diameter of bell: 90.5 mm All measurements excluding tenons
