### Description

Satin finish, silver-plated brass. Gold wash bell interior. Written range: Bb-F. One octave key. Bis Bb, side Bb, forked F#, and side C keys. Alternate G# trill key. Mother-of-pearl touchpieces. Black little finger rollers. Key location on bell (from player's perspective) with low C# and low Bb on right side; low B on left side.
