Description

Silver-plated brass. Written range: Bb-F. Dual octave keys. Bis Bb, side Bb, forked F#, side C keys. Alternate high front F key. Split Eb key. Alternate low Bb, low B and low C# touchpieces on right hand. No mother-of-pearl. Black little finger rollers. Keys on bell (from player's perspective) with low C#, low B on right side; low Bb on left side.
