## Description

Brass body with gold-brass finish; hexgonal receiver ferrule Fixed leadpipe, double loop; main tuning slide with push-rod-activated quick-change to A at second bow (push rod lost). Single water key ath the first bow and the third valve slide French rim Three bottom-sprung Périnet valves with steel pistons with one lug on piston for alignment in groove of vave casing; knuckled-out porting; touchpieces with mother-of-pearl inlay. Lyre holder at third valve slide receiver
