Description

The Regent was a line of the Ohio Band Instrument Co., established by Foster A. Reynolds in 1936. It produced approximately 3750 instruments a year, making it likely that the current trumpet was produced in that year. Silver-plated brass body, satin finish, bell interior gold plated; finger buttons with mother-of-pearl inlay Main tuning slide at first bow with push-rod-activated quick-change to A (rod missing) French rim Single water key at main tuning slide Three bottom-sprung Périnet valves with one key on piston, fitting in groove inside valve casing
