Description

Bundy was a trade name of H. & A. Selmer Co., after it moved to Elkhart, Indiana. George Bundy had become manager in 1927. Silver-plated brass, bell interior gold plated; mother-of-pearl finger buttons Main tuning slide with push-rod-operated quick-change to A at first bow French rim with iron wire insert Single water key at main tuning slide Three bottom-sprung Périnet valves with one key on piston, fitting in groove inside valve casing Trigger with pull ring at third valve slide
