Silver-plated brass body with gold-plated bell flare and bell interior Fixed S-shaped leadpipe; main tuning slide at first bow (two alternative slides for high pitch and low pitch), push-rod-activated quick-change to A slide at second bow (push rod lost) Main tubing enters third valve; stepped, knuckled-out intervalve porting French rim with iron wire insert Single water keys at main tuning slide and third valve slide Three tower-sprung Périnet valves, three unequal guidepin; steel pistons; mother-of-pearl touchpieces
