"Cavalier" was a student-line brand of Pan American, a division of the C. G. Conn company in Elkhart, Indiana. Silver-plated brass, satin-finish; mother-of-pearl touchpiece inlays. Narrow body ("peashooter" model) Three bottom-sprung Périnet valves, one lug on piston.
