Description

Single-loop, two-part brass body; leadpipe and first part in one, bellpipe and bell in one; joint covered by a ferrule with central ring Six keys with flat key heads; lowest key open with adjustment screw; all others closed. Box mounts Brass flat springs riveted on key shanks Undecorated brass garland Saxon rim with iron wire insert Tab seam at bell bow and bell Telescopic tuning slide with wing screw at leadpipe
