Top: two-piece, quarter-cut spruce: medium, wavy grain broadening toward the flanks Back: two-piece, quarter-cut maple: faint, narrow curl descending slightly from center joint Ribs: quarter-cut maple: plain Head and neck: maple: plain; varnish removed from neck and scroll chamfers after application Edging: varnish removed from edges after application Varnish: dark red-brown shaded spray varnish Fingerboard: black-varnished dark brown tropical hardwood; later Nut: missing Tailpiece: missing Pegs: four black-stained pearwood Saddle: ebony; finished with same varnish as body Endpin: black-varnished pearwood; small, highly-rounded head; no collar F-holes: highly offset notches; notches angled steeply down toward in interior; undercut; inside edges stained black Linings: spruce Corner blocks: spruce hollow lower corner blocks; no upper corner blocks Top block: spruce; shallow Bottom block: spruce; shallow Bassbar: carved from top; wide; short; low height Other: bending marks visible on inside and outside of ribs; circular saw marks visible on inside of ribs; tool marks on scroll
