Description

Top: two-piece, quarter-cut spruce: fine grain converging on center joint in upper bouts Back: two-piece, quarter-cut maple: faint, narrow curl descending from center joint; prominent ray flecks Ribs: quarter-cut maple: faint, narrow curl Head and neck: maple: plain; inside of pegbox stained black; varnish removed from neck after application Edging: varnish removed from edges after application Varnish: dark red, shaded spray varnish Fingerboard: black-stained maple Nut: ebony Tailpiece: see accessories Pegs: four black-varnished pearwood Saddle: ebony; finished with same varnish as body Endpin: black-stained pearwood F-holes: slightly undercut; inside edges stained black Linings: spruce Corner blocks: spruce hollow lower corner blocks; no upper corner blocks Bassbar: carved from top Other: circular saw marks visible on inside of ribs
