Description

Top: two-piece, quarter-cut spruce: medium grain, broadening toward the flanks Back: two-piece, quarter-cut maple: narrow curl, descending slightly from center joint Ribs: quarter-cut maple: faint, very narrow curl, angled to the right on Bass side, angled to the left on treble side; rib corners chamfered Head and neck: maple: narrow curl; inside of pegbox stained black Varnish: dark red Fingerboard: black-varnished, dark tropical hardwood Nut: missing Pegs: three black-varnished pearwood Saddle: ebony; finished with same varnish as body Endpin: missing F-holes: flared wings; undercut; inside edges stained black Linings: spruce Corner blocks: spruce hollow lower corner blocks; no upper corner blocks
