### Description

4 sections: barrel, top joint, bottom joint, bell. "Albert" system; 15 touchpieces; 4 ring keys; wood body; nickelsilver keys, rings, ferrules; no rollers for little finger keys; has patent C-sharp; has extra touchpiece on C-sharp/G-sharp key for trill; has left hand alternate A-flat/E-flat touchpiece; bell not original to this clarinet.
