Description

4 sections: barrel, top joint, bottom joint, bell. "Albert" system; 14 touchepieces; 2 rings; wood body; nickel-silver keys, rings, ferrules; has rollers for little finger keys; no patent C-sharp; extra trill touch for C-sharp/G-sharp key; has raised tonehole on front of clarinet for register vent. Appears to be part of "matched set" with NMM 736, 737, and 738.

Dimensions

Measurements exclude tenons. Complete from top of barrel to bottom of bell: 502 mm Bore at bottom of top joint: 13.6 mm
