Description

Silver-plated brass Fixed leadpipe; double loop; first bow leading into the rotary valve quick-change to A, followed by the conical main tuning slide at the second bow; main tubing entering third valve on the right and exiting first valve on the left. Three tower-sprung Périnet valves, two unequal guidepins each The valve loops are splaying outward and do not have valve slides
