



## Cornet, B-flat, A, high pitch / low pitch

### Description

Silver-plated brass, mother-of-pearl touchpiece inlays  
Fixed leadpipe, trumpet-shape body Main tuning slide with insert slide; quick-change to A with pushrod Three tower-spring Périnet valves with two wide guides each. This unknown model seems to have been built as narrow-receiver cornet and as wide-receiver trumpet.
