This kit, or dancing master's fiddle bow, illustrates in miniature some features of late 18th century bow making, such as a strongly pointed tip and hatchet-shaped head. Stick: round; ironwood or other very dark, open-pored tropical hardwood Head: swan tip; T-mortise Frog: ivory; no slide Adjuster: ebony Tip plate: none
