An electric, monophonic, keyboard instrument. Keyboard compass of 32 notes from C to a. 4 control knobs, a switch, and a dial on front External , detached speaker Outer case cover folds back to expose a built-in metal music rack Instrument designed to remain inside traveling case into which it is built. See additional information in this file. The emicon was capable of producing a variety of timbre reminiscent of the violin, cello, saxophone, oboe, English horn, and trumpet, for example.
