### Description

Six-keyed clarinet in boxwood copied from an instrument by August Grenser, who worked in Dresden, Germany. This example includes separate pieces for playing at different pitches (corps de rechange) and was commissioned by the NMM. Two additional barrels were made for this instrument by Daniel Deitch, San Francisco, California.
