Silver mouthpiece, stamped: VINCENT BACH 3C The Bach Stradivarius 180 Series is intended for all-round playing. The 72 model bell taper represents a standard bore for a strong, powerful sound. The "ML" stands for medium bore (0.459 inches). The five-pointed star on the bell indicates that this trumpet possesses a lightweight bell.
