Description

Brass, German silver, single loop, telescopic tuning slide at leadpipe, three rotary valves (1, ½, 1½), horseshoe stop, Leipzig spiral-spring return. This instrument resembles the Bohemian long model B-flat flugelhorn depicted in a catalog from ca. 1925 by Josef Glassl in Graslitz. It was therefore made during the era of Anton Konrad Hüttl jun., who died in 1920, and not while the firm' s founder Anton Konrad Hüttl (1826-1901) was still active.
