Description

German silver, one bow, telescopic tuning slide with gear adjustment at leadpipe, three top-action string-operated rotary valves (1, $\frac{1}{2}$, $1\frac{1}{2}$), stop arm, flat-spring return. The Saxon-born Franz Kaiser and William Kohler are listed as musical instrument makers Kaiser & Kohler from 1859 to 1890 in Cincinnati, Ohio.
