### Description

Nickel-silver-plated brass; French rim with iron wire insert; ferrules with engraved lines; no tuning slide; plastic mouthpiece. Pionersky gorn (pioneer fanfare) were used at ceremonies of the Pioneer Organization, established after Lenin's death (1924). The members of this organization were children aged 9-14, who met annually at summer camps.
