Brass; one narrow loop, bell bent 90 degrees to form a handle; no tuning slide. Free adaptation of a walking stick trumpet, invented by Thomas Harper and manufactured by John Augustus Köhler in London, prior to February 1833. An original example of a walking stick trumpet by Köhler survives at the Royal College of Music in London (nr. 296).
