### Description

Brass, double loop, tuning slide at second bow, two Stölzel valves (1,  $\frac{1}{2}$ ), screw alignment. Typical early French Stölzel-valve trumpet, as depicted in George Kastner's *Manuel général de Musique militaire*, Paris 1848, as "trompette à deux pistons."
