Description

Brass, polished and lacquered (body), German silver (leadpipe, ferrules, valve parts, water key), narrow single loop, telescopic tuning slide at leadpipe with ligature screw, four mechanical-linkage rotary valves to lower the pitch by a whole tone, semitone, minor third, and fourth, ball-and-socket joint push rods, horseshoe stop, spiral-spring return, single water key at fourth valve slide, windway 4-3-2-1. German-silver telescopic tuning slide. Silver mouthpiece, stamped: 1½ C Typical late 20th-century Markneukirchen-style piccolo trumpet.
