### Description

Brass, polished and lacquered, nickel-silver (ferrules, finger hooks and ring, finger buttons, valve caps, valve parts, water keys), mother-of-pearl inlay (finger buttons), single loop, main tuning slide at first bow (alternatives for G and F), three Périnet valves (1, 1/2, 1 1/2), bottom-sprung, alignment by one key on nickel-silver-plated brass pistons, single water key at main tuning slide, trigger with thumb hook at first valve and with pull ring and stop rod at third valve, windway 3-2-1. Two alternative sets of main tuning slides and valve slides for G and F. This high G /F trumpet for the performance of baroque pieces was originally owned by Walter M. Chesnut (1936-2007), trumpet professor at the University of Massachusetts,

Amherst, from 1967 to 2001.
