Stick: round; pernambuco Head: rounded back lacking chamfers Frog: ebony; silver ferrule, heel-plate, and lining; large American abalone eyes (later)\*, American

abalone slide (later)\*; silver pin in heel-plate on underside of frog; rounded heel Adjuster: ebony; two silver bands; mother-of-pearl eye Tip plate: ebony-lined ivory; later Wrapping: silver Grip: black leather
