Description

Boxwood body, originally in three sections (only middle joint and bell survive). Two brass keys with springs attached to the wood. The style of turning is consistent with later Leipzig oboe making, which was similar to the work of early Dresden makers.

Dimensions

Lower joint: 198 mm (223 mm with tenon) Bell section: 154 mm
