Stringing: four gut strings Soundboard: one-piece, slab-cut birch Back: one-piece, slab-cut birch Sides: one-piece, slab-cut birch Head: birch; shield-shaped Neck: birch;

integral with head; faceted neck heel Heel cap: none Binding: none Fretboard: integral with neck; 12 brass frets; white celluloid dots behind 3rd, 5th, and 7th frets Nut: dark hardwood Bridge: dark-brown-stained hardwood; integral saddle; rounded lower edge Tuners: four nickel-plated brass tension tuners with black plastic heads Rosette: soundhole bound in white celluloid Finish: medium brown stain Linings: birch Neck block: birch; nail through top block into neck End block: birch Top braces: light hardwood transverse braces above and below soundhole Back braces: spruce transverse braces in upper and lower bouts
