#### Description

Top: two-piece, quarter-cut spruce: fine grain broadening toward the flanks Back: two-piece, quarter-cut maple: prominent medium curl descending steeply from center joint; small maple pin through back into top block; small maple pin through back into bottom block Ribs: quarter-cut maple: prominent medium curl angled to right on bass side, angled to left on treble side; lower ribs divided by maple strip surrounded on each side by purfling strips; rib corners chamfered Head and neck: maple: medium curl; inside of pegbox stained dark brown Varnish: medium red-

orange; slightly shaded Fingerboard: ebony Nut: ebony Tailpiece: rosewood with beveled face; ivory saddle Tailgut: black plastic Pegs: four rosewood with ivory pins; undercut heads Saddle: ebony Endpin: rosewood with ivory pin F-holes: lower wings channeled; inside edges stained dark brown Linings: basswood Corner blocks: basswood Top block: spruce Bottom block: basswood Bassbar: spruce Other: inside of body stained light brown
