Brass (body), nickel silver (garland, ferrules, valve parts, bow guard), double loop in circular formation, main tuning slide at first bow, three Périnet valves (1, $\frac{1}{2}$, $1\frac{1}{2}$), top-sprung, spring outside hollow stem, alignment by one key on nickel-silver-plated brass pistons, single-water key at main tuning slide, windway 3-2-1.
