Description

Brass, mother-of-pearl finger buttons, single loop, telescopic tuning slide with ligature screw at leadpipe, three Périnet valves (1, ½, 1½), bottom-sprung, alignment by on key on brass pistons, single water key at first bow, trigger with pull ring at third valve slide, windway 1-2-3. Telescopic brass tuning slide. The “Monopole Conservatoire” was a trademark by Couesnon & Cie., Paris, for high quality instruments, aimed at conservatory level professionals rather than brass band amateurs.
