## Description

Stringing: four nylon strings Soundboard: two-piece quarter-cut spruce: fine grain Back: two-piece koa; narrow, irregular curl Ribs: two-piece koa; narrow irregular curl; the ribs comprised of two pieces with the joint along center line parallel with plane of top and back, rather than at tailblock Head: slotted; mahogany with thick, narrowly curled koa veneer layered over thinner ebony veneer; integral with neck Neck: mahogany; integral with head; painted black Heel cap: ebony Binding: ebony; three-ply black, light, black hardwood strip trim on top Fretboard: ebony; 14 nickel-silver frets; beveled corners at lower end Nut: bone Bridge: rosewood; bone saddle; strings pass

through holes in bridge into top without bridge pins Tuners: two sets of tuners with decoratively stamped nickel-plated steel plates, nickel-plated steel rollers and ivory plastic heads Rosette: seven-ply light and black hardwood strips, with wider black strip at center Finish: clear Linings: kerfed mahogany or Spanish cedar; upper edge beveled Neck block: maple; rounded edges End block: mahogany or Spanish cedar Top braces: two spruce transverse braces above and below soundhole; three small spruce fan braces; two small spruce angled braces on each side of soundhole; small spruce bridge plate Back braces: two mahogany or Spanish cedar transverse braces, one each at upper and lower bouts; light hardwood center graft
