Four clear nylon strings Soundboard: one-piece white pearlescent plastic Back and sides: green, translucent, textured, injection-molded plastic Head: green, translucent, textured, injection-molded plastic; front face of white pearlescent plastic; integral with body and neck; face with raised translucent yellow, green, brown, and black plastic hummingbird feeding on flower. Neck: green, translucent, textured, injection-molded plastic; integral with body and head Heel cap: none Binding: none Fingerboard: molded green, translucent, textured plastic with 13 integral frets, including zero fret; white ink dots behind 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 12th frets, not including zero fret; frets painted silver Nut: green translucent plastic; integral with fingerboard Bridge: green translucent plastic Tuners: four nickel-plated steel tension tuners with white plastic heads Rosette: green translucent plastic peace sign set into soundhole Finish: none Linings: none Neck block: none End block: none Top bracing: 10 molded fan braces; soundhole reinforcement Back bracing: none
