Renaissance lute, after Hans Frei (fl. 1545-1564), Bologna, Italy 8-course lute; eleven yew ribs with ebony spacers; neck of poplar; fingerboard and pegbox trim of Brazilian rosewood; belly of spruce with simplified geometric rosette; nylon strings

Length of body, to neck: 505 mm Maximum body width: 315 mm String length: 612 mm
