Description

Stringing: four gut or nylon strings Soundboard: onepiece, slab-cut birch Back: one-piece, slab-cut birch Sides: two-piece, slab-cut birch Head: birch; shield-shaped Neck: birch; integral with head; slightly faceted neck heel Heel cap: none Binding: none; white paint along upper edge in imitation of binding Fretboard: brown plastic affixed to neck with four Philips' head screws, one behind 1st fret, one behind 5th fret, and two after 12th fret; 12 integral brown plastic frets, plus a zero fret; recessed, whitepainted dots behind 3rd, 7th, and 10th frets Nut: brown plastic, integral with fretboard Bridge: birch; integral saddle; curved upper edge Tuners: four nickel-plated brass and steel tension tuners with asymmetrical white plastic heads Rosette: abstract ivory stencil-painted rosette Finish: dark brown sunburst paint with abstract ivory stencil-painted rosette and matching decoration below bridge; white-painted imitation binding along top edge Linings: kerfed birch Neck block: birch; wood dowel through top block into neck End block: birch Top braces: birch transverse brace with tapered ends above soundhole; spruce transverse brace with tapered ends below soundhole Back braces: spruce transverse braces with tapered ends in upper and lower bouts
