Description

The dowel through the top block may indicate manufacture by the Harmony Company. Stringing: four gut strings Soundboard: one-piece Masonite; overhangs sides Back: one-piece Masonite; overhangs sides Sides: one-piece Masonite; joint stapled behind neck heel Head: birch; shield-shaped head Neck: birch; integral with head; roughly machine-carved; heel does not extend to back Heel cap: none Binding: none; white silk-screened line around edge of top in imitation of binding trim Fretboard: black-painted Masonite, terminating in a point with concave edges; held to neck and top with three staples; 10 raised frets, not correctly tuned; yellow, silk-screened dots behind 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th frets Nut: birch Bridge: spruce; strings pass over bridge to steel tailpiece Tuners: four white plastic Tailpiece: black-painted pressed steel, affixed to lower bout with nail Rosette: white silk-screened line set in from soundhole edge Finish: orange paint on top and back with sprayed dark-red sunburst; dark-redpainted sides, neck and head Linings: none Neck block: roughly cut spruce; wood dowel through top block into neck End block: roughly cut spruce Top braces: none Back braces: none Strap: yellow and red cotton cloth strap
