This turn of the century musical invention was advertised as more than a mere harmonica, a player can sing through the mouthpiece or get a "wa-wa" effect by waving one's hand in front of the funnel opening. This novel harmonica includes its original box and instruction book. Clover-branded Harmonophones were sold by both Ferdinand Strauss and Seydel Söhne in Germany.
