horizontal curl; grain converges on center joint in upper an lower bouts; ebony dowel through back into top block on treble side of center joint; ebony dowel through back into bottom block on bass side of center joint Ribs: quarter-cut maple: faint, medium curl; irregular grain; rib corners rounded Head and neck: maple: faint, medium curl; inside of pegbox stained dark brown Varnish: medium orange-brown Fingerboard: ebony; probably later Nut: ebony; probably later Tailpiece: rosewood; white plastic saddle; beveled face; later Tailgut: black plastic Pegs: rosewood with undercut heads and white plastic pins Saddle: ebony; finished with same varnish as body Endpin: ebony; brass eye; turned groove around edge Fholes: slightly undercut; lower wings channeled; inside edges stained dark brown Linings: spruce Corner blocks: spruce
