Description

Stringing: eight steel strings in pairs Soundboard: twopiece, quarter-cut spruce: narrow grain broadening to medium at the flanks Back: one-piece rosewood Ribs: rosewood Head: mahogany veneered with rosewood on face; integral with neck; volute on back of neck at head position Neck: mahogany; integral with head; V-shaped profile Heel cap: black tropical hardwood, possibly ebony; set in from back Binding: ivory celluloid on top with trim comprised of angled light, dark, red-stained, and green-

stained hardwood blocks of various widths surrounded on each side by red-stained hardwood strips; ivory celluloid on back with no trim Fretboard: ebony bound with ivory celluloid, with black wood trim on sides of neck; 17 nickel-silver T-frets; single mother-of-pearl dots behind 5th, 7th, 10th, and 12th frets; mother-ofpearl strip engraved "HARWOOD" behind 16th fret Nut: bone Bridge: ebony; bone inlaid strip Tailpiece: nickel-plated brass string holder with engraved cover; attached with three domed, slot-head screws into lower rib and block Tuners: two pairs of worm-gear tuners with steel plates and brass rollers and black celluloid heads Rosette: oval soundhole bound in ivory celluloid with rosette comprised of trim comprised of angled light, dark, red-stained, and green-stained hardwood blocks of various widths surrounded on each side by red-stained hardwood strips, light hardwood strips, alternating light and dark hardwood blocks, and dark hardwood strips Pick guard: imitation-tortoise-shell celluloid with scalloped lower outline, inlaid with abalone and mother-of-pearl eagle holding two light, blue-stained, and red-stained hardwood American flags Varnish: orange with craquelure on top; transparent elsewhere Linings: kerfed mahogany Neck block: mahogany with beveled corners End block: mahogany with beveled corners Top bracing: three mahogany braces with tapered ends at upper, center and lower bouts Back bracing: three mahogany braces with tapered ends at upper, center and lower bouts Grafts: mahogany Other: circular saw marks visible on inside of sides
