

## Description

This transitional bow has a long, curved tip in its original form, which was often cut off by players as fashions for bows changed. Stick: round; pernambuco; uneven faceting at handle Head: swan head with pronounced nose; rounded outline to front and back edges Frog: dark tropical hardwood; no slide; decoratively cut back edge; slides in grooves cut in handle; probably later Adjuster: ivory; tapered Tip plate: none Wrapping: none Grip: none
