Stick: octagonal; pernambuco Head: small nose; square outline to leading edge; rounded outline to back edge; sharply-defined ridge; no chamfers on back Handle: small nipple Frog: ebony; rounded back edge; silver ferrule and heel-plate; nickel-silver lining; two pins through lining into

frog, one on each side of eyelet; silver pin in heel-plate on underside of frog and on back of heel plate near handle; front corners of ferrule rounded; abalone eyes enclosed in silver rings; abalone slide Adjuster: ebony; two silver bands, the outer one with two silver pins touching one another on one face; imitation mother-of-pearl plastic eye Tip plate: ebony-lined ivory Wrapping: black and beige translucent alternating imitation-baleen plastic Grip: black leather
