Stringing: four gut strings Soundboard: one-piece cedrela [cigar box] Back: one-piece cedrela [cigar box] Ribs: cedrela Head: wood Neck: wood; integral with head Binding: none Fretboard: ivory-painted wood; 12 nickel-silver frets Nut: wood Bridge: wood Tuners: four nickel-plated steel tension tuners with ivory-painted black plastic heads Rosette: pierced, with black painted letters "JT" across front Finish: ivory paint Lining: tan paper, original to cigar box
