Description

Strings: four strings, attached at base of instrument on an end pin, and wound around wooden pegs at opposite end. Body: wood, handmade, unvarnished and unstained light-colored wood. All pieces and side held together by small flat-headed iron nails. Resonating box is six pieces nailed together in a rectangular shape. A hole is cut out of top for soundhole and a small piece nailed to bottom of soundboard to act as a bridge. Neck and peg box are one integral part. Pegs are wood, hand-carved, and somewhat triangular in shape. Pitches: no pitch designations. Hitch Pins: one, wood.
