### Description

Stick: round; pernambuco Frog: ebony; silver ferrule and heel-plate; nickel-silver lining; Stanhope lens with image of Pierre Hel with cello, surrounded by abalone ring; abalone slide; rounded heel; single silver pins on underside of heel plate and at back of heel plate near stick Adjuster: ebony; two silver rings; silver pin in one facet of each ring; abalone eye Tip plate: ebony-lined ivory or ivory plastic Wrapping: silver Grip: black leather
