### Description

Stick: round; pernambuco Frog: ebony; silver ferrule, heel-plate, and lining; abalone eyes surrounded by silver rings (Parisian eyes), highly figured abalone slide; silver pin in heel-plate on underside of frog; silver pins through lining into frog on each side of eyelet; rounded heel Adjuster: ebony covered in silver; silver pin in one facet Tip plate: ebony-lined ivory Wrapping: silver Grip: black snake leather
